**Opioid Reassessment Clinic Quality Improvement Consultant:* collaborated with opioid reassessment clinic clinicians to evaluate current data set, looking specifically at demographics of clinic patients, outcomes of care, and effectiveness of intervention, Edith Nourse Rogers Memorial Veterans Hospital, Bedford MA 2018-2019

**Telehealth Expansion Co-Project Lead:* QI project to address low utilization of same day access at satellite locations for mental health services through telehealth expansion, Developed concept and initial plan using PDSA framework. Current utilization rate of telehealth for same day mental health service was 0%, goal to reach benchmark of 75% with telehealth access, Edith Nourse Rogers Memorial Veterans Hospital, Bedford, MA 2018-2019

**Measurement Based Care Project Lead:* Developed QI project to address depression-related measurement-based care (PHQ9) utilization rates within primary care-behavioral health team. Pre-intervention, rates of baseline and follow-up PHQ9 administration for veterans with a depressive disorder were 76% and 35%, respectively. Following intervention, provider PHQ9 utilization rates increased to 98% and 88% at baseline and follow-up, Edith Nourse Rogers Memorial Veterans Hospital, Bedford, MA 2017-2018
