

2024-2025 Verification Worksheet Dependent Student

Your 2024-2025 Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) was selected for review in a process called verification. The law states that before awarding Federal Student Aid, we may ask you to confirm the information you reported on your FAFSA. To verify that you provided correct information, the financial aid administrator will compare your FAFSA with the information on this worksheet and other required documents. If there are differences, your FAFSA information may need to be corrected and your financial aid would be adjusted accordingly. Be sure to check your IHP email regularly as emails are often sent when additional information is required after review. You and your parent(s) must complete and sign this worksheet, attach any required documents, and email the forms to financialaid@mghihp.edu. Incomplete forms without all required documents attached will not be accepted. No aid can be disbursed until the verification process is complete.

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The provided criteria for "dependent children" or "other persons" align with the requirement that family size align with whom the parent could claim as a dependent on a U.S. tax return if the parent were to file a U.S tax return at the time of completing the 2024-2025 FAFSA. As a result, the parent should not include any unborn children in the family size.
