**IMPORTANT NOTICE TO PHD IN REHABILITATION SCIENCE CANDIDATES:**

Tuition for this program will be discounted 100% for the first four years of enrollment. Students will be responsible for paying a per credit general fee and a per credit technology fee each term at the current general student fee and technology fee rates. (minimum of 34 credits).

Students are also required to take a minimum of three supplementary courses relevant to their area of research. These supplemental courses are taken at the Institute, or more often at one of the many top-level universities in the Boston Area. Tuition costs for these courses may be covered if the courses are taken at institutions with which we have established agreements. Otherwise these additional costs must be covered by the student.

After course completion, students are in the dissertation phase of the program, typically starting in the third year after their qualifying exam and extending through the fourth year, culminating in their thesis defense. Beginning in the fifth year of enrollment, the student is responsible for the Continuing Enrollment Fee charged at the current rate. Once in continuation phase, the general student fee will also be charged at the rate of 1 credit for each semester until the dissertation is completed.

Academic PEAT Practice Exam	<b>\$79</b>	Charged first semester (summer) of third year, the Academic PEAT is a practice exam, developed by the FSBPT to help students prepare for the National Physical Therapy Examination (NPTE®). The Academic PEAT includes a practice exam and assessment tool (PEAT) and a timed, computer-based, multiple-choice practice exam for NPTE candidates. Experienced clinicians and item writers have developed questions in the same format as the NPTE to help students identify their strengths and weaknesses prior to taking the actual exam.

Late Payment Fee I	<b>\$275</b>	This charge will be added to all unsettled balances on the day following the payment due date. Settled balances include full payment and, or, documentation for account clearance. Documentation for account clearance and balance justification includes the following: Tuition Management Systems enrollment confirmation, National Health Service Corps Scholarship letter, or other awarded financial aid. Awarded financial aid must be greater than the balance due to avoid the late payment fee. This supporting documentation must be received by the Financial Aid or the Student Accounts Office prior to the payment due date. <b><i>This fee is non-refundable.</i></b>
Late Payment Fee II	<b>\$275</b>	This charge is assessed to any student with an unsettled account balance on the 13th class day following the start of the term, regardless of when a student's actual class starts. Settled balances include full payment and, or, documentation for account clearance. Documentation for account clearance and balance justification includes the following: submission of payment to Tuition Management Systems prior to the 13th class day, National Health Service Corps Scholarship letter, or confirmation of awarded financial aid. Financial aid documentation must be greater than the balance due to avoid the late payment fee II. <b><i>This fee is non-refundable.</i></b>
Transcript Fee (per transcript)	<b>\$10</b>	This charge is assessed to any student requesting an "official" copy of their academic transcript issued by the MGH Institute. Official transcripts bear the official seal of the Institute as well as the signature of the Registrar. They are printed on secure transcript paper and sent in secure envelopes. Unofficial transcripts are free of charge, but do not carry the seal of the Institute or the signature of the Registrar and are printed on plain paper. Unofficial transcripts are not considered official documents of the Institute. <b><i>This fee is refundable if a request is cancelled for any reason.</i></b>

Health Service Fee		This fee is assessed to students at each semester. This fee is to provide students with a comprehensive set of health and behavioral health resources and services, such as One Medical (all programs), Exact Immunization & Certification (on campus and Clinical Programs); MGB Occupational Health resources and services (on campus and clinical programs) and MGB Annual N95 Fit testing (required for clinical placements).
