

Q: Please tell me about your program.

A: If you go onto our website at www.mghihp.edu, click on Academics/School of Nursing and find the program that interests you. You will find information about the course of study, about the prerequisite courses and about the application process.

Q: Where can I take the prerequisite courses?

A: Prerequisite courses can be completed at any regionally accredited college or university in the U.S., including community colleges.

Q: Do you accept prerequisite courses from online institutions?

A: Online courses are acceptable if they are from an accredited institution.

Q: Do the prerequisite courses need to include a lab?

A: No, a lab component is not required.

Q: Do I have to have all of the prerequisites completed in order to apply?

A: For the ABSN and DEN programs, applicants may have no more than one course in progress during the semester prior to anticipated matriculation.

Q: Do students find their own clinical placements?

A: No, the School of Nursing clinical education staff and the faculty arrange clinical placements for all students.

Q: Is there an application process for scholarships?

A: No, there is not. See the website for information under financial aid.

Q: Can I transfer courses in from another school?

A: There is a process for courses to be reviewed by the Assistant Dean of the program. This review takes place once you are matriculated in the program.

Q: Do you have a part time program?

A: Our accelerated Accelerated Bachelor of Science in Nursing and our Direct-Entry Master of Science in Nursing program are both designed as full time programs.



COURSE TITLE	NOTES
Human Anatomy & Physiology I & II	1 semester of human anatomy and 1 semester of human physiology are acceptable. Lab component is not required.
Microbiology	Must include content on microbes. Lab component is not required.
Human Growth & Development	Aka: Developmental Psychology Course must cover lifespan including physical, cognitive, and emotional development. Multiple courses cannot be combined to cover lifespan.
Human Nutrition	Course must cover Human Nutrition across the lifespan. Exercise, sports or weight control courses do not meet this requirement.
Statistics	Must include inferential statistics.
